On behalf of your members playing from Wyoming Tennis Courts I would like your Committee to write to the Committee of the Wyoming Tennis Complex with the following requests:-

1. All rubbish (lollie papers, rotten fruit, glass and twigs) be removed from the actual tennis courts.
2. The Caretaker be requested to completely hose the courts at least weekly to prevent a backlog of leaves and general rubbish.

Whilst we fully realise that leaves will be a continual problem, if they are removed frequently, this will prevent the buildup occurring and thus blocking the water from draining away off the courts after rain.
