No further action has been done re grading committee.

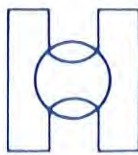
Z Kyzelis to look into a system where every player registered with club be graded so to try and avoid problems when grading teams and "fill in" players.

Dear Mr. Nagle,

We acknowledge receipt of your letter of 8 July, 1992 concerning the matter of Permits for the Interdistrict Competition and our decision in relation to the Shelley Molony matter.

In arriving at our decision to allow Shelly Molony to play Interdistrict with Toukley, we took into consideration the following factors:

1. The fact that the Constitution of the N.S.W. Country Association does not provide for permits for the Interdistrict Competition.
2. The wording of Rule 24 of the Interdistrict Rules.

As you aware, initially the Competition Committee made an interpretation of the Rule. This interpretation was overturned, on appeal, by the Grand Council.

There is a view that Rule 24 can be interpreted in different ways. I feel sure that in the light of this experience this Rule will be reviewed prior to the commencement of next year's Competition.

Should you still require a copy of the Country Constitution, I suggest you contact the NSWTA Director for your area.
