Suitable insurance policy must be produced to competition secretary prior to private court being included in competition.

GDFA current insurance arrangements do not cover anybody on the court who is taking part in a match. Included are the players, umpires and linespeople. Accordingly, a direction was given to LMW that for upcoming final series that only central umpires would be allowed on the court with the players. Umpires could then be classified as volunteer workers and as such could be covered on our insurance policy.
