Wet Weather Rule for Saturday Mixed Comp.

Decision as to whether play will commence on wet days to be left to the discretion of the Tennis Sub Committee.

Decision to be made no earlier than  $\frac{1}{2}$  hour prior to commencement time.

Outside courts to be up to the discretion of court owners/caretakers.

If courts are deemed unplayable 1 hour after starting time then Tennis Sub Committee or owners/caretakers of outside complexes, make decision as to whether play is abandoned or not. After commencement of play

further decision re wet weather will be made by Tennis Sub Committee on the day.

These rules do not cover Semi Finals, Finals or Grand Finals.
