3. STARTING TIME:

3.1 Now Reads

After a toss of a coin to decide who serves first, the deciding set commences. In this deciding set the first team to score five (5) games will an advantage of two (2) or more games, wins the set and thus the match. However, in the event of a draw - four (4) games all, the set will continue until one team has an advantage of two (2) games.
