Also add Ann Thomas and Steve Mann to Tennis Committee now to be  
known as Competition Committee.

JUNIOR COMM  
REPORT: Final of the Junior Badge to be played on Saturday on two courts, 4  
divisions in total. Have arranged for a sausage sizzle when completed.  
Who is going to run Junior Badge next year?  
Still have some single and double matches to be played in the Junior  
Club Championships.

GENERAL BUSINESS: Membership fees for 1999 will be:-

Bryce Grossell has agreed to act as the Appeals Chairman again next year.

Team Registration will be the same as 1998, but should there be any variation in format then the Sub Committees must inform the Main Committee.

A maximum court hire charge for all competitions. Meeting with Rod Rosenfield before new competitions commence to finalise amount to be charged.

Players can supply their own balls if they wish for any of our competitions. It was suggested that a letter be sent to all captains explaining this - to be discussed again at our next meeting.

Discussion regarding article in the local about the Nationals. No where did it mention G.D.T.A.

Apparently another Junior Squad coaching is being run on a Wednesday by Rod Rosenfield, but the Association has not been informed about it. It was agreed that at the start of next year we must insist that we have Category 2 Coaches for our Junior Squads.

The State Member for Gosford is Chris Hartcher and the Federal Member for Gosford is Jim Lloyd. Letters to be sent to them also the Mayor of Gosford Chris Holstein for being nominated at our AGM to be our Patrons for 1999.

Tennis NSW Grants - Tech. Service Group need to be contacted in 1999 to try and arrange a loan from them to up-grade the courts, Courts 1-4 need to be up-graded before Nationals. \$62.00 per hour for 2 people to clean courts 1-4 and put new lines on has been quoted. Some courts at bottom complex need patching.

Lead-ins for 16 Nationals start 30/12/98. Suggest we have a players BBQ New Years Eve and Managers Meeting. It was also suggested that the opening ceremony be held New Years Eve. Fifty two girls events and ninety two boys events in lead-ins. Seventy eight girls and one hundred and three boys in main event.
