TREASURERS REPORT: Account from Neilly Davies & Ptnrs for Bottom Complex Advice of \$400.00 - passed for payment.

Robyn Davis presented 3 deposit slips for monies banked.

Account from Gosford Council for \$360.00 for removal of fallen tree - checking with Michael Stone of circumstances and confirming if this is due for payment or not.

Account from Gosford Tennis Centre for \$1,000 being balance of monies claimed for Gosford Junior Open and Gosford Open.

Bank Statements unavailable as Treasurer unable to be present.

L.M.W. REPORT: Concreting at bottom complex completed and paid. Still awaiting quote re Vanity. We have problems with ladies discontent re night comp on Monday Night, have had a lot of rained outs and complaints they will not play again, hope to run a Round Robin on Finals Night for those not playing to assist this problem. Some feel they should not have to pay full registration fee for just the one comp. Trophy costs may need to be looked at with less teams.

Have been asked by some ladies if we can issue a Voucher to be used towards personal registration if they do not wish to take Trophy or Open Order on Shop. Will discuss further. Query re the use of cricket shoes on grass courts, these are not acceptable, must wear correct tennis attire, including tennis shoes. Request to use tennis balls gained from Country Week for the Round Robin, this will be o.k. Maureen rang Tennis NSW and confirmed that all umpires, including lines persons, are covered under Player Registration.

TENNIS COMM

REPORT: Matthew feels that most teams in 1, 2 and 3 are for 2 x 2 format. Steve advised that division 1 use this format and perhaps we should try 1, 2 and 3. Dennis suggests if the kids playing the Badge progress to division 6 they would be better with 2 x 2. Divisions 4 and 5 remain 3 and 2.

It was recommended by Pat Healy and seconded Hal Moir that we try divisions 1 and 2 with 2 x 2. The problem with this is the cost, currently paying \$45.00 for court and balls.

Recommendation that court hire be \$33.00 and 3 balls. Pat, Troy and Jamie to discuss with Rod. Jamie has suggested Team Registration Fees - each player be charged a fee of say \$9/10.00 instead of a set team fee, this is to stop players registering in teams if they are not going to play. To be discussed further.

Who is responsible for chasing "forfeit" money as Anne has list who have not paid - felt it is up to Comp Secretary.

Anne advised Protest letter from Pat Webb re Thursday Night Comp was discussed on Saturday, and no change from original decision on grade. Rang Pat Webb and advised this and explained they could send letter to Appeals Committee, however chose not to do this.

There is a small shortfall in cost for trophies.

Tuesday Night Comp has 4 divisions with 30 teams. 2 x 8 and 2 x 7.

Thursday Night has 4 x 6, lowest division is to play on a Wednesday Night as there are not enough courts.

#### JUNIOR COMM

REPORT: Presentation Night was very successful. Balls supplied for Round Robins from Macquarie Generation, the centre hosting would get 1 doz free balls, however we have 40 doz and have paid for 40 doz. Dennis will attempt to rescind motion as he feels this should not happen.

GENERAL BUSINESS: Fencing - Steve has spoken to Rod about court 9. The sign he put up has created the problem, which Rod does not feel is so. There is also a problem with court 5. Rod claims the fences are old and the signs are not the problem. Steve Gibson moved we write a letter to Central Coast Tennis Centre regarding signs, he will look into the actual signs effected and advise Maureen prior to writing the letter. Steve advised Sue Harrison passed away, request that we forward a Sympathy Card.



Steve advised Income & Expenditure Statement for Open Tournament not ready yet, should be presented at the next meeting.

Regarding account for further \$1,000 from Gosford Tennis Centre, figures should be as under:

Re: GOSFORD OPEN

29th January - half day from midday  
30th " - full day  
31st " top complex (half complex)

This totals 2 full days by \$500.00 per day = \$1,000.00 (as agreed by Steve Gibson). This amount has been paid.

Re: JUNIOR OPEN

Same costing as last year which was \$2,000.00 and no agreement to increase this figure. The \$2,000.00 has been paid.
