Jamie advised the books have been audited and he is waiting on the Report.

Credit balance is approximately \$13,000.

Maureen stated she had taken down the Nomination Sheet. The Committee sheet should not have gone up, as under our new Constitution, these nominations are made from the floor at the A.G.M. and the Executive sheet comes down 14 days prior to A.G.M. In future, this will apply to L.M.W. also, they should only put up Executive Nominations.

Pat stated she feels the L.M.W. President should be on the Main Body Committee. Maureen feels this would be a good idea, particularly as other Main Body Committee have not gone back onto L.M.W. Committee. Hal will ring Sylvia and discuss this with her.

Jamie advised he did not receive G.S.T. report from L.M.W. and this has caused problems.

Discussion was held re fees to be put to the A.G.M. We have been behind with our finances as the Player Registration Fee went up just after our A.G.M. and this was absorbed by us on this occasion.

Suggested fees for 2003:

ADULT	\$28.50 plus Player Registration
SENIOR	\$26.00 plus Player Registration
JUNIOR	\$16.00 plus Player Registration

(this represents an increase of \$1.00 each).

Patrons – we normally have The Mayor and Local & Federal Member. The L.M.W. should, under our Constitution, not have a separate Patron. They would be best to use a name other than Patron.



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A letter was received from L.M.W. re the amount of sand on courts 5, 6 and 7 and it is considered hazardous. Sand has since been removed from these courts.

They also requested a dividing fence be erected between courts 10 and 11. Copy of this letter was given to Bryce Grossel (Grounds Committee).

Bryce tabled report on Seminar "Between the Lines" which he attended on 13.9.02. This will be discussed in detail at next monthly meeting.
