

MINUTES OF EXECUTIVE MEETING HELD WITH GTC ON 13.10.03

Matters discussed -

PHONE:

GTC have not, in the past, charged GDTA for any calls made on their behalf. As these calls take up much of the GTC phone and prevent incoming calls, GTC ask that an extension be placed in their Reception area to enable Jenny or Val to make these calls on our behalf.

The blue chairs in the "Blue" room, which have been there for many years, are now rusting and dangerous. Decision made that 50 new chairs be purchased, GDTA will look into costings and suitability.

WOODEN BENCHES:

There are still 5 of these that have not been made stable and the bases need "supports". This should be attended to urgently as we already have a court case over an incident involving one of these seats.

NIGHT TENNIS:

Some of the Night tennis teams have new members who are not familiar with requirements, etc. It would be good to have a leaflet to hand out to these new members. Maureen will follow up with Pat, as she did have one on her computer.

GOSFORD JUNIOR ENTRY FORM:

Rod has on his computer, but stated he will not be doing the tournament if Dennis Stimson is Referee or in a "key" position.

Entry should be limited to 2 singles (1 odd, 1 even) , 1 doubles and 1 mixed event.

Dates will be 16-21st January, 2004 and Lynne Buchanan will be asked to be Referee.

GOSFORD OPEN ENTRY FORM
