MATTERS DISCUSSED:

CLUBHOUSE - BOTTOM COMPLEX -

Discussion was held re what could be done to make this more secure following recent attempted break-in which has virtually wrecked the roller shutter to front window.

Maureen has suggested bricking both outside window areas in and making a serving window in the entrance area which would be protected with the full roller door, which is more secure than the window areas.

Rod to get a quote from one of our members to brick these in for us to present at our next GDTA meeting on 7/12/05.
