LICENCE WITH GTC DISCUSSED MEETING 13/9/07.

Meeting held with our Solicitor on 21/8/07 to go through current Licence and seek his advice on how we stand having received other "Expressions of Interest".

In relation to our income, Lynne advised the Junior Open is still doing well. Memberships are down, but we are still generating reasonable income.

Steve still feels we should run the full term of the current Licence. 10 years ago we were happy to receive 5 "Expressions of Interest" and the price we got was reasonable. We are still getting that price.

Steve moved to rescind the motion of the meeting on 9/8/07 and call for another vote "that we go the full term and call for "Expressions of Interest", seconded Dennis. 5 for, 3 against, 1 abstained (carried).

Hal informed the meeting that had the CPI been enforced over the years, the annual figure would now be in the vicinity of \$71,000. Further discussion suggested a figure of say \$80,000.

Maureen moved to rescind the above motion, seconded Lynne. 6 in favour, 3 against (carried).

Maureen moved fresh motion, seconded Lynne, that "we proceed with Licence offer to GTC inserting a figure of \$80,000 per annum and subject to various discussions from August meeting. If they do not accept (date to be determined) then we ask for "Expressions of Interest". 6 in favour, 3 against.

Dennis moved an amendment that the figure be \$120,000, failed to get a seconder.

Steve felt Jenny and Rod should be informed of this now as the matter will be discussed at AGM. It was agreed that Hal and Steve would inform them following this meeting.
