Committee Meeting – COVID 19 issues Discussed 28 March 2020 – 4pm

These were the points discussed at last Saturday's meeting:

Accessibility/Coaching

We agreed to restrict access to those with keys, and that we are not to be seen as taking court-hire or coaching. Coaches can hit with players however cannot allow any visitors to enter.

It was important that anyone who had opened the gates would lock them behind as they enter to ensure safety and non-access of members of the public. Mike advised there had been an incident on Saturday morning of a homeless person who accessed the property and was ill on the premises.

Since Saturday there has been updated guidelines to social distancing and restricting group numbers to only 2 persons.

Maintenance

Mike indicated that he and Paul would maintain the property – lawnmowing, spraying, hedging, etc. Paul would need around 3-5 hours per week for this and to be reviewed monthly.

Garden club and other volunteer programs to cease.
